

## CHAMPAGNE AND SPARKLING WINE

### NV Brut Réserve, Charles Heidsieck, Champagne, France

(Btl £65.00, 125ml £11.95)

Complex pastry aromas, with a combination of ripe apricot, mango and greengages, dried fruits, pistachio and almond.

### NV Rosé Réserve, Charles Heidsieck, Champagne, France

(Btl £75.00)

Freshly picked strawberry aromas gradually become more intense, with home-made strawberry jam and blood peach alongside rich, warm notes of gingerbread and cinnamon.

### 2005 Brut Millésime, Charles Heidsieck, Champagne, France

(Btl £95.00)

On the nose the aromas are autumnal and warm with notes of praline and lightly toasted hazelnuts.

### NV Grande Réserve, Devaux, Champagne, France

(Btl £50.00)

The wine has a lovely Pinot Noir richness on the nose, with aromas of baked apples and vanilla.

### NV Cuvée Rosé, Laurent-Perrier, Champagne, France

(Btl £105.00)

Revealing the full aromatic richness of the Pinot Noir grape, this precise and intensely fruity rosé is blended from ten different crus.

### 2006 Cristal Brut, Louis Roederer, Champagne, France

(Btl £295.00)

The flavours are typical of Chardonnay: rich, fleshy peach and mandarin citrus fruits developing into white acacia flowers, dried fruit and buttery caramel hints.

### NV Prosecco Superiore Spumante DOCG Asolo, Ca' Morlin, Veneto, Italy

(Btl £28.00, 125ml £5.50)

This Asolo Spumante is soft, scented and grapey, with delicious lightness and a long lasting 'mousse'.

### NV Spumante Rosato, A Mano, Puglia, Italy

(Btl £30.00, 125ml £5.75)

Raspberries, fresh cherries, orange blossom and toasted hazelnuts all come through.

### NV Franciacorta `Alma` Gran Cuvée Brut, Bellavista, Lombardia, Italy

(Btl £30.00)

Perfumes of white flowers and stone fruits, with subtle hints of vanilla.

### 2011 Blanc de Blancs, Hattingley Valley, Southern England,

(Btl £65.00)

Green apple aromas with citrus on the nose give way to a fresh palate that is slightly softened by the lees ageing and barrel fermentation.
